Taught by APICS Master CSCP/CPIM Instructor, the Introduction to Supply Chain Management course will provide an overview of supply chains and how class participants interact with different aspects of the supply chain. Supply chain fundamentals will be reviewed, including the interaction between providing customer service at an optimal value while managing to balance the objectives of inventory management and efficiency. Overview of the supply chain planning hierarchy will take place, including high level tactical planning to day-to-day operational activity to support the executive level plans. Interactive exercises will take place to ensure that participants understand the role of managing the different supply chain flows and how those challenges can be met by more effective planning and stronger relationships with both internal and external stakeholders.
