

Paramedics assess a patient's condition and administer emergency medical care and care for the sick or injured in emergency medical settings.

What Paramedics Do*:

- Respond to 911 calls for emergency medical assistance
- Assess a patient's condition and determine a course of treatment
- Provide first-aid treatment or life support care to sick or injured patients
- Transport patients safely in an ambulance
- Transfer patients to the emergency department of a hospital or other health care facility
- Report their observations and treatment to physicians, nurses, or other health care facility staff
- Document medical care given to patients
- Inventory, replace, and clean supplies and equipment after use
