With the **Certified Nursing Assistant** Apprenticeship 321 program, earn a Nursing Assistant Certificate in just 16 weeks.

Part of a health care team, CNAs are often the principal caregivers in nursing and residential care facilities and work under the supervision of licensed practical or licensed vocational nurses and registered nurses.

What Certified Nursing Assistants Do\*:

- Clean and bathe patients
- Help patients use the toilet and dress
- Turn, reposition, and transfer patients between beds and wheelchairs
- Listen to and record patients' health concerns and report that information to nurses
- Measure patients' vital signs, such as blood pressure and temperature
- Serve meals and help patients eat
