With the **Practical Nursing** Apprenticeship 321 program, earn a Diploma in Practical Nursing in just 3 semesters.

Licensed Practical Nurses (LPNs) and Licensed Vocational Nurses (LVNs) provide basic medical care, working under the direction of registered nurses and doctors.

What LPNs and LVNs Do*:

- Monitor patients' health—for example, by checking their blood pressure
- Administer basic patient care, including changing bandages and inserting catheters
- Provide for the basic comfort of patients, such as helping them bathe or dress
- Discuss the care they are providing with patients and listen to their concerns
- Report patients' status and concerns to registered nurses and doctors
- Keep records on patients' health
