

BASIC SKILLS NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION

To attend the Adult High School or the GED Program, students **must** attend a four-day new Student Orientation. Students must attend all **four** days. There is no cost for Orientation.

Returning students who have been out three months or more must attend the full orientation.

Things you **must** bring to Orientation:

- Valid NC Driver's license or NC Identification card (must have an actual card and not the print-out from DMV)
- Social Security Card
- Students under 18 (16 & 17 only) must have completed Minor Paperwork
- Unopened transcript (if testing for the Adult High School Program)

You will NOT be allowed to attend Orientation without the above items.
