*\*Biology courses must have been taken within 10 years OR proficient score of 58.7 on science portion of TEAS*

### Co-Requisite Courses Completed (by end of fall semester)

1 course = 1 point      |      2 courses = 2 points      |      3 courses = 3 points      |      4 courses = 4 points

### Co-Requisite Courses Taken at Gaston College

1 – 2 courses = 1 point      |      3 – 4 courses = 2 points

### Grade Point Averages (GPAs)

#### PN Co-Requisite Course GPA

*Only the 4 co-requisite courses listed above*

2.0 – 2.4	1 point
2.5 – 3.0	2 points
3.1 – 3.5	3 points
3.6 – 3.8	4 points
3.9 – 4.0	5 points

#### Cumulative Biology GPA

*BIO 168 and 169*

2.0 – 2.49	1 point
2.5 – 2.99	2 points
3.0 – 3.49	3 points
3.5 – 3.99	4 points
4.0	5 points

*In order to qualify for cumulative biology GPA points, an applicant must have both biology courses completed by end of fall semester.*

#### ATI TEAS Score

60	= 0 points
61-63	= 1 point
64-66	= 2 points
67-69	= 3 points
70 and above	= 4 points

#### ATI TEAS Science portion

58.7-65	= 1 point
65.1-75	= 2 points
75.1-85	= 3 points
85.1+	= 4 points

### Completion of: Nurse Aide, or Phlebotomy at Gaston College

Completion of Nurse Aide I or II course at Gaston College 1 point

Completion of Phlebotomy program at Gaston College 1 point

Completion of ATI TEAS Prep Class with Gaston College 0.5 point

Holds baccalaureate or higher degree 1 point

Completion of Gaston or Lincoln County Schools Health Science Course (state-approved Nurse Aide I class) 0.5 point
