



## Program Eligibility

### Are you eligible for WIOA youth services?

1. Are you between the ages of 16-24 and live in Gaston County?

#### Barriers

- Are you a school dropout or in a GED/HSE/AHS program?
- Are you pregnant and/or a parenting youth?
- Are you an offender?
- Do you have a mental health diagnosis or disability?
  - Do you have an Individualized Education Program (IEP)?
- Are you considered homeless, a runaway, or in foster care?
- Are you considered basic skills deficient (TABE) or an English language learner?
- Are you currently unemployed or under-employed? (18+ only)

\* If you are 16 or 17, your parents or guardians must be unemployed or under-employed and you must say yes to at least one of the barriers above in order to be eligible.
