Re: NEW MSF Curriculum and Class Information

Welcome to the newly updated MSF program. Please read this information completely BEFORE coming to class.

The first class will be held on Thursday night, 6:00-10:00 PM, on the main campus (201 Highway 321 South, Dallas, NC. Click here for map/directions.) of Gaston College, computer lab in Room 214, Dalpiaz Building. This is an on-line session that ends with the written test of the information required by DMV. The two motorcycle rider/coaches who will be teaching that weekend will be in the classroom, facilitating your session. At 10:00 PM, you will print your certificate of completion and give it to the rider/coaches. **This is a mandatory session**. Be prepared to start promptly at 6:00 PM on Thursday. Being tardy may result in forfeiture of your tuition.

Saturday and Sunday's classes will be held at our MSF range and classroom, located behind Ashbrook High School's football stadium, 222 South New Hope Road, Gastonia, NC. (Click here for map/directions.) Please enter the Ashbrook parking lot at the southern entrance and follow the fence-line down and through the chain-link gates. These two days will be the skills portion of our class and will take place rain or shine.

You will need the following equipment: (WE PROVIDE THE MOTORCYCLES)

- 1. Your personal DOT approved helmet. (A few loaner helmets are available.)
- 2. Eye protection
- 3. Long-sleeved shirt and long pants
- 4. Over the ankle boots
- 5. Full-finger gloves

## There will be NO REFUNDS or TRANSFERS AFTER 9 AM on MONDAY BEFORE YOUR CLASS.

You must call before 9:00 AM on the Monday before your class to be entitled to a refund or to transfer. The certified rider/coaches are authorized to remove anyone from the course who might pose a danger to themselves or others. We do not anticipate this happening. Additionally, no visitors are allowed on the range. Please do not invite anyone to come and watch, especially minors.

If you have no past motorcycle riding experience, it may be to your benefit to practice your balance by riding a bike before the class. You must pass both the skills/riding portion of the class as well as completing and passing the computer/written test.
