Comments: New Hampshire, New Mexico, North Dakota, and Oregon require state licensure, but all sonography licensees are required to hold a national sonography certification/credential. American Registry of Diagnostic Medical Sonography (ARDMS) administers examinations and awards credentials in the areas of ultrasound.

Program graduates are qualified to sit for three ARDMS exams including Sonography Principles and Instrumentation, Abdomen, and Obstetrics & Gynecology.
