



Peru 2027 - Frequently Asked Questions

Question – How much is the down payment?

- Answer: The deposit amount is \$500. Of this, the non-refundable deposit amount is \$100.00.

Question – What is the deadline for making the deposit to reserve my place?

- Answer: The deposit must be made by **November 15th, 2026**.

Question: When is the final payment/total amount due:

- Answer: The final payment is due **March 15th, 2027**.

Question: How do I make my deposit and payments?

- Answer: The GC business office number is: 704 922 6208. You should be able to make payments using a credit card. Just make sure you ask them to send a copy of the receipt to Mrs. Beth McCall at mccall.beth@gaston.edu.

Question: Can I make several payments?

- Answer: You can make payments toward the trip as long as the final payment is made on or before **March 15th, 2027**

Question: Will I need a passport?

- Answer: You must have your passport by **March 1st, 2027** to go on this trip.

Question: How do I apply for a US passport?

- Answer: Google this question for a step-by-step guide. Start early on this step!

Question: Is there a way to get class credit for the trip?

- Answer: Students may take HUM 120, which will have Peru-centered content, for class credit. Other students may ask their teachers if there is a way to receive honors credit by taking the trip and completing a trip-centered assignment.

Question: Can I apply for scholarship assistance to help with the cost of the trip?

Answer: Yes!

1. Apply for this year's FAFSA BEFORE submitting a scholarship application.
2. Scholarships are processed through a committee and awarded to your travel account if accepted.

4. The deadline for scholarship applications is **November 1st, 2026**. It is suggested that you complete this application once you have registered and paid your trip deposit.

If you require assistance with walking, you will need to plan for that. Trip participants, faculty, and ISA-I staff will not be able to assist you. You will also need to be able to manage your own luggage and belongings.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

In general, program participants will not receive a full refund if the study abroad program is set to run within 120 days. Before that point, all money paid directly to the college will be refunded, less \$100.00, unless funds have been paid to outside vendors.

- Program participants will be subject to the cancellation policy of the study abroad provider.
- Gaston College cannot provide refunds for any monies paid to outside entities.
- While traveling abroad, health insurance will be provided by Gaston College.
