Learn and Earn Online (LEO) is a program allowing high school students to take introductory-level college courses online and earn both college AND high school credit.

Any qualified public or charter school student in grades 9-12 can enroll in Gaston College LEO courses as long as they have met college requirements and required course prerequisites. Students should check with their school guidance counselor for specific information about participation.

- The courses are ONLINE and are taken at your high school as part of the regular school day.
- There is NO COST to students for the course(s) or textbook(s).

HOW GASTON COLLEGE LEARN & EARN ONLINE WORKS.....

- Students take online college classes on the high school campus during a scheduled period or block of time in a computer lab or room with available computers such as a media center or distance learning classroom.
- Courses are taught by GASTON COLLEGE faculty who are accessible to students.
- These are the same GASTON COLLEGE courses that are offered to all students who take courses on any of the GASTON COLLEGE campuses or through online delivery.
- There is no charge for students to participate.

HOW GASTON COLLEGE LEO MAKES SCHEDULING EASIER.....

- High Schools provide an adult facilitator for each class and GASTON COLLEGE provides the instructor for each online course thereby having no impact on your teacher allocation.
- The computer and network resources required are simple and flexible.
