GETTING STARTED IS EASY

1 APPLICATION

Complete the NC Residency Determination at ncresidency.org first, then complete our online application at cfnc.org/gastonapp.

2 TRANSCRIPTS

Submit your official high school, GED, or previous college transcripts by mail to Gaston College, ATTN: Admissions, 201 Highway 321 South, Dallas, NC 28034 or via an approved online transcript service to admissions@gaston.edu.

3 ORIENTATION

A link for orientation will be emailed to you after applying. Complete the short online orientation to receive advising and registration access.

4 PLACEMENT

An unweighted high school GPA is used to determine placement for anyone graduating within the last 10 years. Other students should visit gaston.edu/testing for additional waiver and placement test information.

PAYING FOR COLLEGE

Your success is our mission and we don't want the cost of a college education to stand in your way. Gaston College offers low tuition rates while still providing the same high-quality education available at other colleges and universities. In addition to a tuition rate that is typically 50-75% less expensive than 4-year public or private universities, we also provide financial aid and scholarships for eligible students.

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) determines your eligibility for valuable federal and state grants. The FAFSA opens Oct. 1 each year and should be completed by all students online at fafsa.ed.gov as early as possible. Gaston's Title IV school code is 002973.

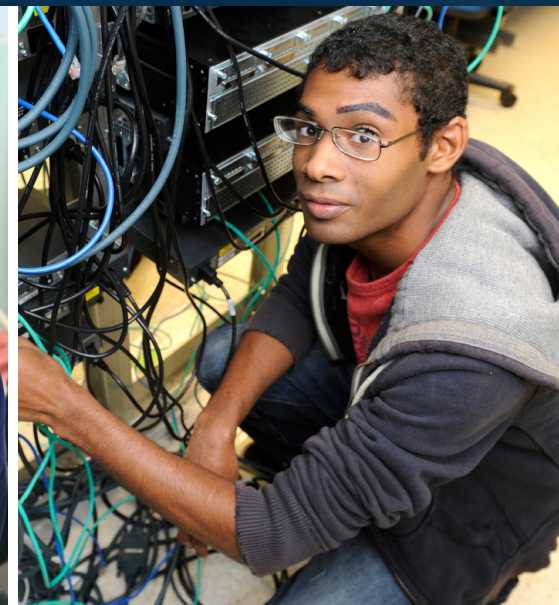
